Title: Hanne Jensen Solidarity Collection

Dates: 1983-1984

Physical Description: 12 cm of textual records; 411 files (325 MB) of digitized newspaper and magazine clippings

Administrative History: Hanne Jensen was director of the BC Human Rights Branch whose position was eliminated as a result of the 1983 provincial budget and accompanying legislation. She became a public figure during the Solidarity movement in British Columbia before moving to Ontario to work for the Canadian Human Rights Commission.

Scope/Content: The collection consists mainly of newspaper clippings, intact issues of newspapers and newsletters. These items have been digitized and are archived by the BC Labour Heritage Centre.

Other items include flyers, leaflets press releases, ephemera, reports, agendas, minutes, correspondence and notes, some relating to Jensen's termination in July 1983. The collection was shared with the BC Labour Heritage Centre in 2018 as part of the 35-year retrospective project, Solidarity35. It is in the order originally donated, duplicate items were removed.
