

- We work to ensure that workers' stories continue to inspire today's labour movement
- We build public understanding of the contributions of unions that benefit every worker



We deliver quality research which makes history relevant to today's unions. This past year alone, we have achieved a lot.

- ✓ Restored **Ginger Goodwin's gravestone** in Cumberland and strengthened connections to his Yorkshire roots.
- ✓ Recalled labour's long fight to oppose racist **apartheid** in South Africa.
- ✓ Published new research on **women's work** in transit, garment factories and fruit-packing plants.
- ✓ Chronicled the relationship between the labour movement and the **New Democratic Party**.
- ✓ Re-visited the historic 1947 meatpacking strike where **support from unions** was pivotal.
- ✓ Collected new interviews with labour activists from **all regions** of BC.



Oral History

Interviews with labour leaders and activists in all regions; processing, publishing and promoting their stories before they are lost forever.



Archives

Preserving and digitizing physical, audio and visual materials from the movement, including publications, recordings and photographs.



Education

Lesson plans, Labour Heritage Video moments, podcasts and newsletters are tools for classroom teachers and union education programs.
